- ⇒ **Fee**—\$75/camper, \$125/camper & parent! (teens \$20)
- ⇒ **Deadline**—Must be received **by February 10, 2012**
- ⇒ **How to register**—The 4-H Center must receive a completed registration form and payment no later than the deadline above.

## IMPORTANT INFORMATION:

- ⇒ Cloverbud programs are open to children ages 5-8 years old **ONLY** (with the exception of trained teen/adult volunteers and parents), according to Virginia 4-H age guidelines.
- ⇒ Supervision will include a 1 to 5 camper to counselor ratio and includes overall supervision by Virginia Cooperative Extension faculty & staff.
- ⇒ Campers should not bring money, iPod/MP3 players, video games, laptops, cell phones, etc.
