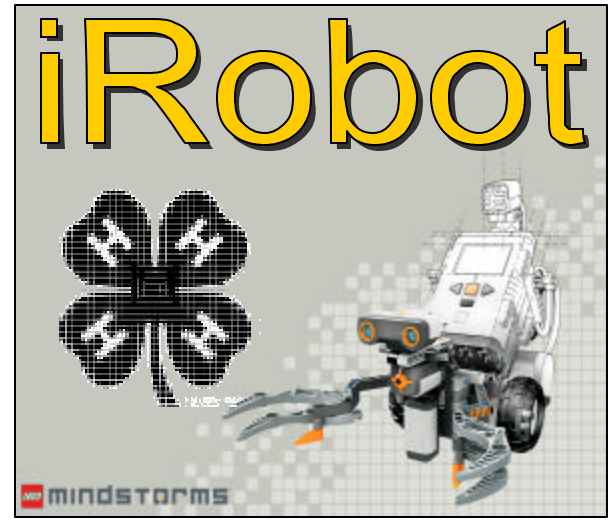

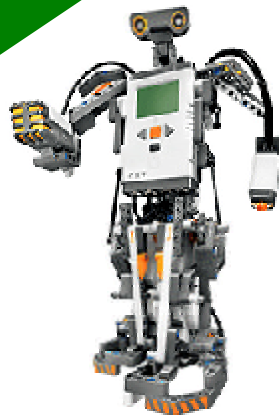

- *How to register—The 4-H Center must receive a completed registration form and payment no later than Jan. 20, 2012

Reminders:

- ⇒ Robotics Camp is open to children ages 10-13 years old ONLY (with the exception of teen/adult volunteers), according to Virginia 4-H age guidelines.
- ⇒ Supervision will include a 1 to 7 camper to counselor ratio, as well as trained adult volunteers and the 4-H Center Outdoor Education Coordinator.
- ⇒ Campers should not bring money, CD/MP3 players, video games, cell phones, etc.

- ⇒ A Camp Medic will be on-site during this program. All medications must be clearly marked, in original containers, and turned in to the Camp Medic upon arrival.
- ⇒ Camp fee is non-refundable after Jan. 20, 2012
