## Reminders:

- ⇒ Harry Potter Camp is open to youth ages 9 to 13 years old ONLY (with the exception of trained teen and adult volunteers), according to Virginia 4-H age guidelines.
- ⇒ Supervision will include a 1 to 7 camper to counselor ratio, as well as trained adult volunteers and the 4-H Center OE Coordinator
- ⇒ Campers should not bring money, CD/MP3 players, video games, cell phones, etc.
